POSITION OF DIRECTOR THE INSTITUTE

Institute of Development Studies, Jaipur invites nominations/Applications for the post of Director of the Institute. The Institute is an autonomous social science research organization supported by the Indian Council of Social Science Research, New Delhi and the Government of Rajasthan. The Institute carries out research studies for understanding the development processes and uses this knowledge for making effective interventions at different level. The main thrust areas of the Institute are Economics and Social Policies, strategies and their impact; Institutions, Governance and Civil Society; Natural Resource Management and Environment; Women and Gender. (For details see our website www.idsj.org). The Institute provides equal opportunity to female and male scholars.

The Director is the executive head of the Institute. The Director is expected to be a researcher/scholar of high eminence capable of providing academic leadership. It is desirable that the Director has atleast 5 years experience in academic/research administration and willing to interact with governments, development agencies and the community at large and should be preferably below sixty two years of age. The Director will be appointed initially for a period of three years but his/her tenure can be extended up to the age of 65 years.

The Director is placed at the highest pay scale of the University Professor (UGC norms) plus allowances and perquisites according to the rules of the Institute.

Applications/nominations accompanied by detailed bio-data should reach the Institute addressed to the Chairman, either by post or at chairman@idsj.org by January 31, 2018. The Search Committee will have the freedom to consider names of scholars who may not have applied or been nominated. Scholars who are short-listed by the Committee may be invited for a discussion.
